## Call for contributions to an art exhibition

The Local Organising Committee of the 10th Congress of the European Association for Palliative Care (7–9 June 2007, Budapest, Hungary) is calling registered participants to contribute to an art exhibition

### Aims of the exhibition

The exhibition will convey the cultural aspects of hospice and palliative care and express the struggles and rewards of working in the field. Artworks should reflect the motto of the congress, '**Connecting Diversity**', either directly or through the free association of ideas.

### Conditions of entry

Applications are invited from registered participants of the congress. Each entrant may submit up to three artworks (from media including photos, paintings, drawings, sculpture, collages and installations).

Featured artworks will be selected by exhibition curators. Please send, in advance, a digital photo of the artwork to [eapc2007@blaguss-congress.hu](mailto:eapc2007@blaguss-congress.hu) with the following:

- Name of the entrant and the title/s of the artwork/s
- Medium, material/s and size of each artwork
- Short curriculum vitae and statement about why you consider your work reflects the aims of the exhibition.

### Deadline for entry

Digital photos of the artworks must be received by **Monday 30 April 2007**. All entrants will be informed of the decision of the exhibition curators electronically. Completed artworks **must be delivered to Blaguss Congress Bureau (Révay köz 2, Budapest 1065, Hungary) by Monday 21 May 2007** or to the reception desk of the congress venue (University Congress Centre ELTE, H-1117 Budapest, Pázmány Péter Sétány 1/a, 1/c) by Wednesday 16.00–20.00, 6 June 2007.

### Care of artworks

Entrants are advised to pack their work in a professional manner for transportation. Packing cases are strongly recommended for delicate works.

Works selected will be insured from their arrival until the end of Saturday 9 June 2007, when the exhibition closes.



The outside of the packaged artwork must be clearly labelled with the entrant's name, the details of the artwork and the name of the exhibition, 'Connecting Diversity'.

### Awards

**1st prize** The winning entry will be published on the cover of a future issue of the *European Journal of Palliative Care*; and the winning entrant will receive a one-year subscription to the journal

**2nd prize** Free entry for two persons to the Gala Dinner at Gellért Bath (including massage or bath ticket)

**3rd prize** A big Hungarian Puli dog (not a real one!)
